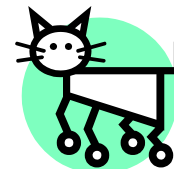

Fabric Classes

Quilt-making 101: Saturdays, June 7, 14, 21, July 5, 12 & 19 12:30-3:00. In this class you will learn to plan, cut and piece a lap size sampler quilt. You will add sashing, borders, backing and get it ready to quilt. This class will prepare you for most other classes we offer. If you or someone you know have always wanted to make a quilt, this is your opportunity! Teacher: Sally \$50.

Hand Quilting: Tuesday, June 10, 10-12. or Saturday, June 14, 10-12. This class is for those of you who have wanted to try quilting by hand or anyone who needs a little refresher. We will cover all the basics beginning with basting, marking, stitching (including "utility" or "big stitch"), using stencils, quilting

with no-knots, "Thimble lady" method and more. This class will be conducted around a traditional floor frame and is limited to 5 students. See you at the Bee!

Teacher: Patsy Preiss. \$30 includes a kit.

Machine Redwork or Outline Embroidery: Tuesday, June 24 10-12:30. Learn to do embroidery using your regular sewing machine and cotton thread. This is great for those of us who never have enough time to do it by hand, but love the look. Stop in to see if your machine does the simple stitch needed. Kit \$4. Teacher: Nan Johnson \$25.

Flowers to Fabric: Roberta Williams Class: Saturday, June 28 10-3. Start with a picture of your favorite garden flower, turn it into a pattern and create your own garden quilt from fabric. Roberta will guide you through this easy and fun way to make a wall hanging designed and made by you. Teacher: Roberta Williams \$40

Lincoln Logs: Wednesday, July 16, 10-4:30 This is Nan's new pattern that uses a jelly roll and just one fabric to make a full/queen quilt quickly. Teacher, Nan Johnson \$35

Machine Quilting: Tuesday, August 5 & 12, 10-12:30. Bring some 'muslin sandwiches' to practice marking, using stencils and free motion designs. Teacher: Nan Johnson \$30.

Start Quilting with Alex Anderson's Book: Saturdays, August 9, 16 & 23. 10-12:30. A beginning class to learn six basic blocks to make a great wall hanging and still learn all the basics of quilting, Teacher: Nan Johnson. \$45.

Rug Hooking: Stop in to look at our rugs and see how they are made. We will try to form a class from interested students!

Yarn Classes

Beginning Knitting: Just stop in some day and we will get you started with a simple scarf. Better yet, come to Open Knitting some Thursday afternoon and learn how with lots of help!

Knit Socks: Sundays, June 8, 22 and July 6, 1-4. Learn to use all the wonderful self-striping yarn or a solid color to make your very own pair of socks. Nancy is an expert and she'll show you all the tricks she's learned! Teacher: Nancy Cressman. \$45.00

The Lucy Bag: Saturdays, June 14 & July 12, 10-12. This is a wonderful felted bag you can make in a variety of sizes and has a looped strap for a closure. Teacher: Nancy Cressman. \$30

Entrelac Hat: Thursdays, August 7 & 21, 10:30-12. Learn a new technique and get a start on a great hat for a gift or yourself! Teacher, Nancy Cressman. \$30.

Choose your own Hat: Saturday, August 16, 10-12:30. Choose from a variety of patterns and learn how to make a simple hat! Teacher, Nancy Cressman. \$15.
